 - Treasurer's Report: Financial Statements. Matthew presented the Treasurer's report, expressing concerns about the revenue tracking, especially the emergency telephone charge. He mentioned that Terry has been dealing with health problems, which delayed the financials. Ryan explained the modified cash accrual basis used for accounting and suggested a meeting with the auditors to address the issue. Gene and Matthew discussed concerns about the revenue numbers, with Ryan explaining the delay in seeing the increase in fees due to the timing of the audit and the implementation of the new rate. They agreed to monitor the situation and consider an audit if necessary.

 - <u>ADCOM Update</u>. Amy provided updates on the PUC task force, mentioning the misuse of the 911 Bill signed by the governor. She also discussed the admin building roof issue, the compensation study progress, and the ongoing work on the Adcom 91 budget.

 - <u>Legal update</u>. Ryan shared that he switched law firms from Fairfield and Woods to Frost Brown Todd, which will not affect his work with the authority. He also provided an update on the

911 tariff rulemaking process, explaining the issues with CenturyLink's tariff and the goal to have a new tariff in place by the end of the year.
